1. CALL TO ORDER / WELCOME VISITORS – David Dupree, Kyle Brummitt, Lorri Brummitt

2. INVOCATION and PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

3. ROLL CALL. QUORUM: Present-Alderman Jeff Burgess, George Cole, Lisa Washington, James Gipson, Mayor Dick Ford

4. ADOPTION OF AGENDA- Alderman Burgess made a motion to accept the agenda as written. Alderwoman Washington second, all in favor.
